Please register your students before the due date to ensure space and allow us time to get the proper materials needed for the event! **Registration and payment are due by Friday**, **February 21, 2020.** We are trying to make registration as painless as possible . . . we just want lots of students! *Please note that payment still has to be mailed to the Science and Math Division*.

The Registration fee (\$5.00 for each student) is due by Friday, February 21, 2020. Please make checks payable to Delta College and send to Delta College, ATTN: Science and Math Division-G211, 1961 Delta Road, University Center, MI 48710. <u>Registration fees are non-refundable</u>; however, you may substitute a different student if necessary. If there is a concern about accommodating a student with special needs, please contact us so we can make arrangements. A special drawing will be held for the first fifteen schools to register!

Students should be selected from their grade and home school of record. Each individual school is allowed to send as many students as they wish (no limit). <u>*Please note that calculators may be used on the exam</u></u>. On the <u>registration site</u> you will find former exams (<i>which may be reproduced*) if you would like to have something for students to practice. Answer sheets are also available on the same site.</u>

On the day of the event, awards will be given to the top twenty-five students in each grade level and all participants will receive a certificate of achievement. In addition, all participants present at the awards ceremony will be eligible for a drawing to win fun math-related prizes. As in the past, activities are planned for parents during the test and for parents, teachers and students between the test and the awards ceremony. Lunch is also available for **purchase** on campus.
